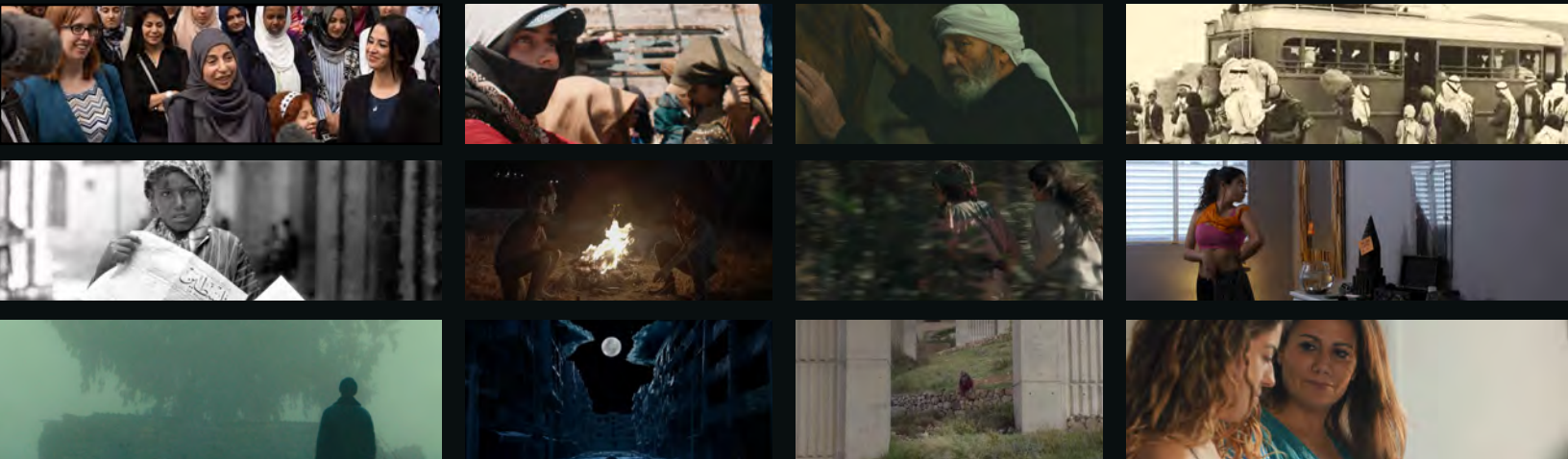

ABOUT THE FESTIVAL

The Boston Palestine Film Festival (BPFF) brings Palestine-related cinema, narratives, and culture to New England audiences.

The festival has featured over 400 compelling and thought provoking films, including documentaries, features, rare early works, video art pieces, and new films by emerging artists and youth. These works from directors around the world have offered refreshingly honest, self-described, and independent views of Palestine and its history, culture, and geographically dispersed society.

From its sold-out opening events to its jubilant concluding nights, the annual Boston Palestine Film Festival continues to meet with an overwhelmingly positive response. BPFF receives coverage in prominent local media outlets, including The Boston Globe and Globe Magazine, The Harvard Crimson, The Harvard Record, The Jewish Advocate, NewEnglandfilm.com, and WBUR (a local affiliate of National Public Radio), to name just a few.

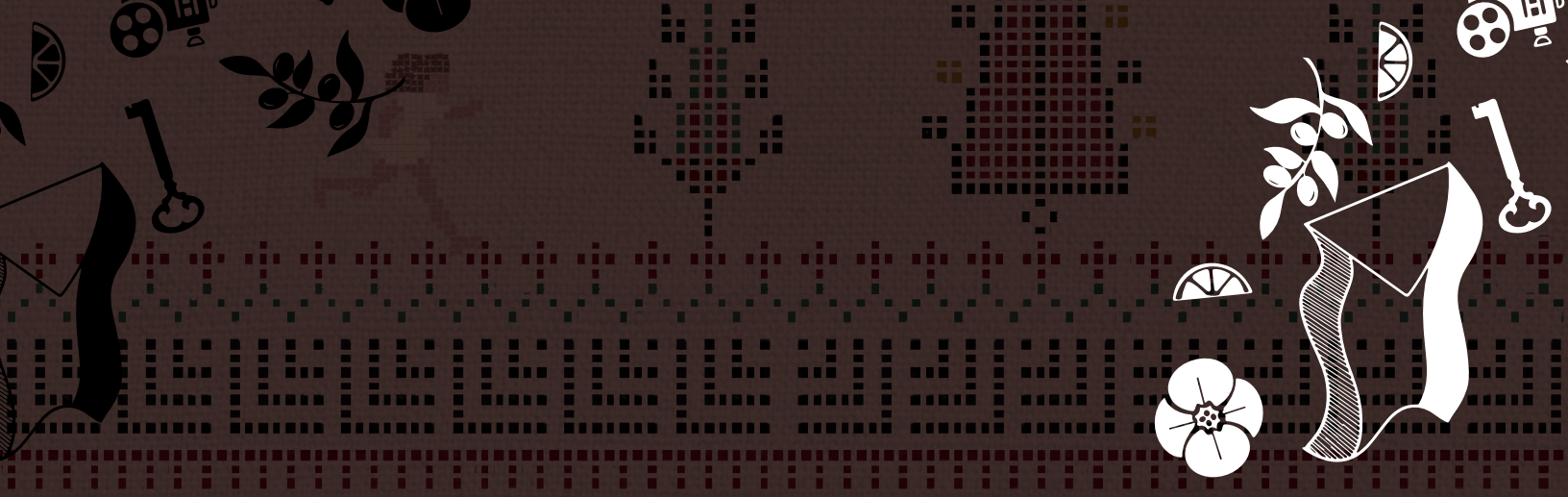
GOLD

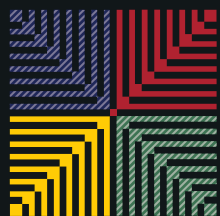
